Dr. Juan Bennett Drummond - \$10,000

Born and raised in New Bedford, Dr. Juan Bennett Drummond (1864-1926) was the first African American woman licensed to practice medicine in Massachusetts. She was a graduate of New Bedford High School and ran a private medical practice out of her home as well as an office above what is now the Zeiterion Performing Arts Center. She was a tireless advocate for her local community and became a co-founder of the New Bedford Home for the Aged.

Hetty Green - \$5,000

Henrietta “Hetty” Howland Robinson Green (1834-1916) lived on 7th Street in Downtown New Bedford and was one of the richest women in the world in the 19th century. At the time of her death in 1916, her net worth was estimated to be about \$2.5 billion in today’s money. She was a major philanthropist known for offering free or low-interest loans to people who often could not obtain them. She was also a strong proponent of financial literacy and empowerment for all women.

Rosetta Douglass - \$2,500

Daughter of Frederick Douglass and New Bedford native Rosetta Douglass (1839-1906) carried on the work of her father as a strong abolitionist and social reformer. She advocated for desegregation of the public schools throughout the 19th century and was a founding member of the National Association for Colored Women (NACW).

Dr. Marie Equi - \$1,000

A native of New Bedford, Marie Equi (1872-1952) was a national leader for women's suffrage, reproductive rights, social justice, and political activism. Her medical practice in Oregon provided free care to low-income individuals from across the state and become a model for future health centers around the country.
